Ahmadiyya Muslim Swiss Peace Award



The Ahmadiyya Muslim community is dedicated to establish peace at all levels and to protect the basic human rights of all. In light of this it is keen to recognise efforts made by anyone to advance the cause of peace. For this purpose, the "Ahmadiyya Muslim Swiss Peace Award" was launched to promote peace and is therefore awarded in recognition of a person's or organisation's contribution to peacebuilding in Switzerland.

The award will be presented for the second time at the Swiss Peace Symposium on 25th April 2024. It includes a trophy, a certificate and a monetary prize of 3000 Swiss Francs.



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THE MAHMUD MOSQUE AN ABODE OF PEACE FOR OVER 60 YEARS.

It is the first purpose-built mosque in Switzerland that was opened in 1963 at Forchstrasse 323 in Zurich. It has always played an important role in inter-religious dialogue, in the education about Islam and its peaceful teachings, and in efforts for social peace.
